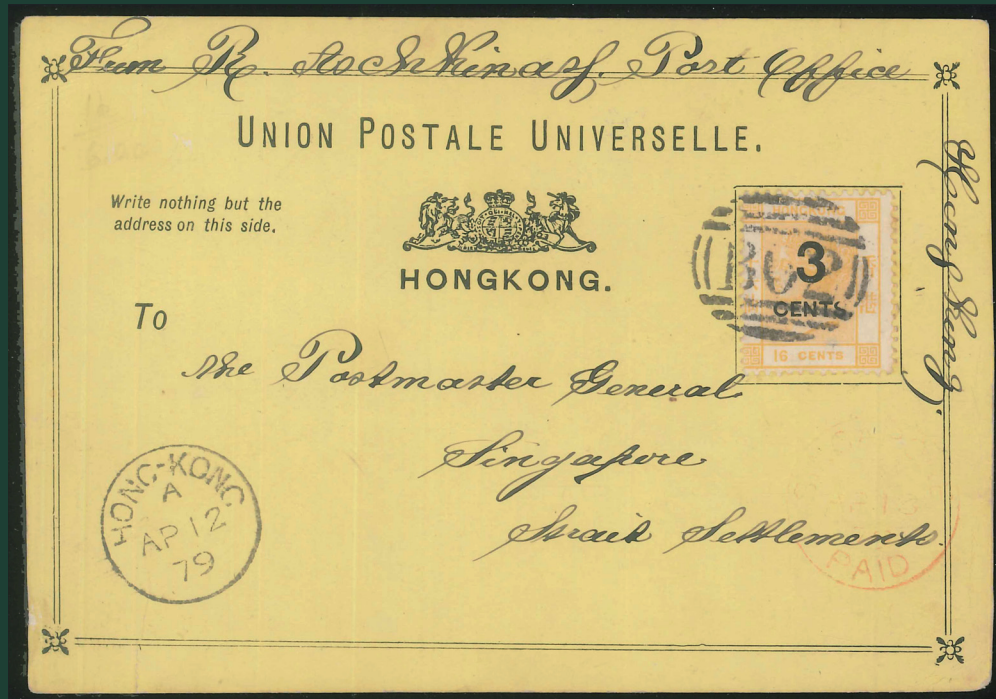

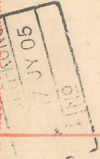

CONDITIONS OF BUSINESS

Starting prices have been given for all lots in this auction. They are meant to reflect our idea of the lowest market value of the item given its scarcity and condition. Lots normally open at or above and may sell for more as biddings dictate.

Postal Bid Forms should be sent or faxed to be received by our office before 12 midnight prior to the day of the auction. For afternoon auctions no later than 12 noon on auction day. Extension on lots should be noted on bid forms. For lots that requested extension, Phila China will submit the item to Mr POON Kam Leung, AIEP, (Association Internationale des Experts en Philatélie), of Experts and Consultants Limited (Hong Kong) for certificates, providing that the lot will be paid for in full plus all charges for expertizing, including courier charges, insurance and handling at the time of purchase. All costs and charges for expertization are the sole responsibility and liability of the buyers.

All lots will be sold to the highest bidder. A 25% Buyer's Premium will be added to the hammer price, on all lots. The buyer agrees to pay all shipping and handling costs. It is solely the buyer's responsibility to notify Phila China Limited of any special shipping instructions.

In the case of tie bids or any other disputes arising, the auctioneer's decision will be final. The auctioneer retains the right to act as seller's agent in placing a protective reserve on any lot.

All invoices are payable in Hong Kong dollars. Payment in any other currencies will not be accepted unless prior arrangements have been made, with such payment to include all additional bank charges. 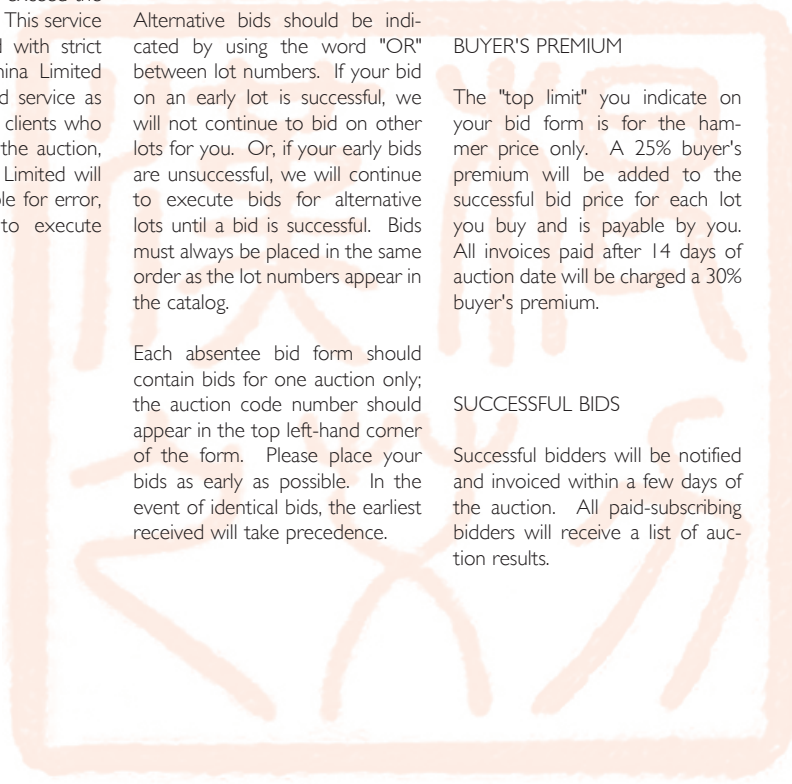

兩代英屬東亞郵政用品郵政史

郵政用品：人跡罕至的路

是次拍賣專集的內容是英屬東亞郵政用品的第一部份 - 香港，而不是郵票。在19世紀初集郵早期，收集郵政用品像郵票一樣熱衷。郵政檔案記載郵政用品是第一批預付郵資的寄信工具：1819年和1820年的撒丁島卡瓦利尼，以及1838年新南威爾士州的信封（在世界第一枚郵票黑便士出現前2年）。在其他國家，如俄羅斯，郵政用品本身是在郵票釋出前幾年發行的。因此，在集郵的黎明，只有一條路。

然後目錄變得更厚、更繁瑣、更昂貴，所以斯科特和其他主要出版商決定從他們的目錄中刪除郵政用品。這發生在20世紀的早期（Gebrüder Senf是1914年版的最後一次堅持）。關鍵是，當這種情況發生時，「集郵的單一道路」分化了（正如詩人羅伯特·弗羅斯特所說），郵政用品變成了「人跡罕至的路」，因為沒有真正的跟蹤方法了。

由此產生的後果是，20世紀發行的許多郵政用品出奇地稀少（由於戰爭，沒有被收藏家儲存），因此很少被理解。1928年德國只有ASCHER，但此後仍然什麼都沒有，20世紀60年代的HIGGINS & GAGE主要基於ASCHER的重複，然後是關於郵政用品文章的發表，最後是開始包括郵政用品的專業級書籍。所以它仍然是一片田地，沒有完全耕犁過。然而埃里希和海因茨·馮·漢根父子的香港集郵用品專輯就在今天，可以把未有記錄的精彩部份呈現。

也就是說，「新生命」仍然可以透過集郵。因此，人們對郵政用品的興趣重新燃起 - 聯合郵政用品協會於2025年出版了一本新的、非常全面的英國東亞文具目錄，這一點變得更加明顯。這次拍賣目錄中所提供的拍品全部選擇跟隨UPSS的編排號碼，因為這是唯一較全面性的列表。除了這一切之外，本拍賣目錄儘量提供一份比較完整的檔案，描述了問題、使用型別和航行的完整故事 - 一段更完整亦揮之不去的歷史。它具有郵票所提供的，而且會更多。

華郵拍賣彙集了英屬東亞郵政用品區域的概述：郵資片、郵資封、掛號郵資封、航空郵簡、包裝紙、信卡等。郵集裡面本身有一些真正的稀有物品，以及使用方面的稀有物品，以及許多小塊來完成每個區域的插圖。正如羅伯特·弗羅斯特所說，這是為了激發你的集郵熱情，讓你沿著「人跡罕至的路」走，這對你來說可以改變一切。

華郵在本次拍賣中為您帶來的這位藏家，畢生熱愛集郵，並積累了豐富的藏品，其中，這部英屬東亞郵政用品-香港尤為珍貴。他年輕時便開始收藏夏威夷城鎮、船、種植園及相關郵戳，以及郵政用品和郵政史。同時，他也建立了一套相當規模的巴拿馬運河區郵票收藏，其中包含大量錯票，以及一套美國南部邦聯臨時郵票。後來，他與父親一起專注於當時鮮為人知的郵政用品領域，並建立了德意志各邦、波斯、印度各邦、英屬非洲以及亞洲的郵票收藏。此外，他也為英國皇家郵學會撰寫了吉列爾莫·加列戈斯（Guillermo Gallegos）所著《19世紀薩爾瓦多郵票》（The 19th Century Issues of El Salvador）一書中的郵政用品部分，因為他認為，經過幾代人的困惑，郵政用品這一主題的複雜性極需釐清。他也收集了一系列獨一無二的俄羅斯郵政史藏品，包括地方自治機構的信箋。此外，他正在撰寫一本應俄羅斯學會委託而作的書籍，該書將聚焦於1877年俄土戰爭期間產生的一小部分但意義重大的信箋，這場戰爭產生了深遠的歷史影響。華郵如此介紹他，是希望藉此表明集郵依然能夠為像你們這樣充滿好奇心和求知欲的人帶來無限的探索和滿足。

POSTAL STATIONERY: The Road Less Traveled By

The content of this and two coming sales, is all about the postal stationery of British East Asia rather than the adhesives stamps themselves. This first part focuses on Hong Kong.

In the 19th century, during the early days of philately, stationery was collected as avidly as stamps. Indeed, the first prepaid postal documents were stationery: the Cavallinis of Sardinia 1819 and 1820, as well as the envelopes of New South Wales 1838 (fully 2 years before the Penny Black made its appearance). And in other countries, like Russia, stationery, itself, was issued years before adhesive stamps were released. So, at the dawn of philately, there was a single road.

Then the catalogs got thicker, more cumbersome, more expensive, so the decision was made by Scott and other major publishers to drop stationery from their catalogs. This occurred during the earliest part of the 20th century (Gebrüder Senf being the last holdout with their 1914 edition). The point being that, when this happened "the single road of philately" diverged (as the poet Robert Frost would have said), and stationery became "the one less traveled by", because there was no real way to keep track any longer.

The consequence of this being, that much of what was issued in the 20th century is surprisingly scarce (not have been saved by collectors and due to wars), and so has been little understood. There was only ASCHER in Germany 1928, but still nothing since except for HIGGINS & GAGE in the 1960's which was based largely on a repetition of ASCHER, and then, articles and finally, specialized county books that began to include stationery. So it is still a field, not fully plowed. Discoveries can, right today, be made.

That is, "New Life" is still possible to philately. Hence, a resurgence of interest in stationery -- which is made all the clearer by the publication in 2025 by the United Postal Stationery Society of a new and very inclusive British East Asia Stationery Catalog. The numbers of which, are used in this sale to indicate the items offered, because they are often the only listings possible. Beyond all this, there is the added excitement provided by stationery because it is always a full document describing a complete tale of issue, type of use, and voyage -- a more complete piece of lingering history that is. It has what adhesive stamps offer, and too, so much more with every piece.

So over three sales, Phila China has brought together an overview of the BEA area in terms of postal stationery: cards, envelopes, registration envelopes, wrappers, letter sheets and etc. From country to country within these sales, are some real rarities in themselves, as well as rarities in terms of use, along with a great many smaller pieces to complete the illustration of each area. And this, to invigorate your philatelic passion by sending you along a road, as Robert Frost would say, along "the one less traveled by", which could make, for you, all the difference.

The collector who Phila China has brought to you in the following sale, has had a lifelong love of philately, and has consequently constructed a diverse group of collections, of which, the following British East Asia is a beloved one.

As a youth, he began with Hawaiian town, steamer, plantation, and ancillary cancels as well as postal stationery and postal history. In conjunction with this, he built a strong showing Canal Zone with a generous array of the errors, as well as a group of U.S. Confederate States Provisionals.

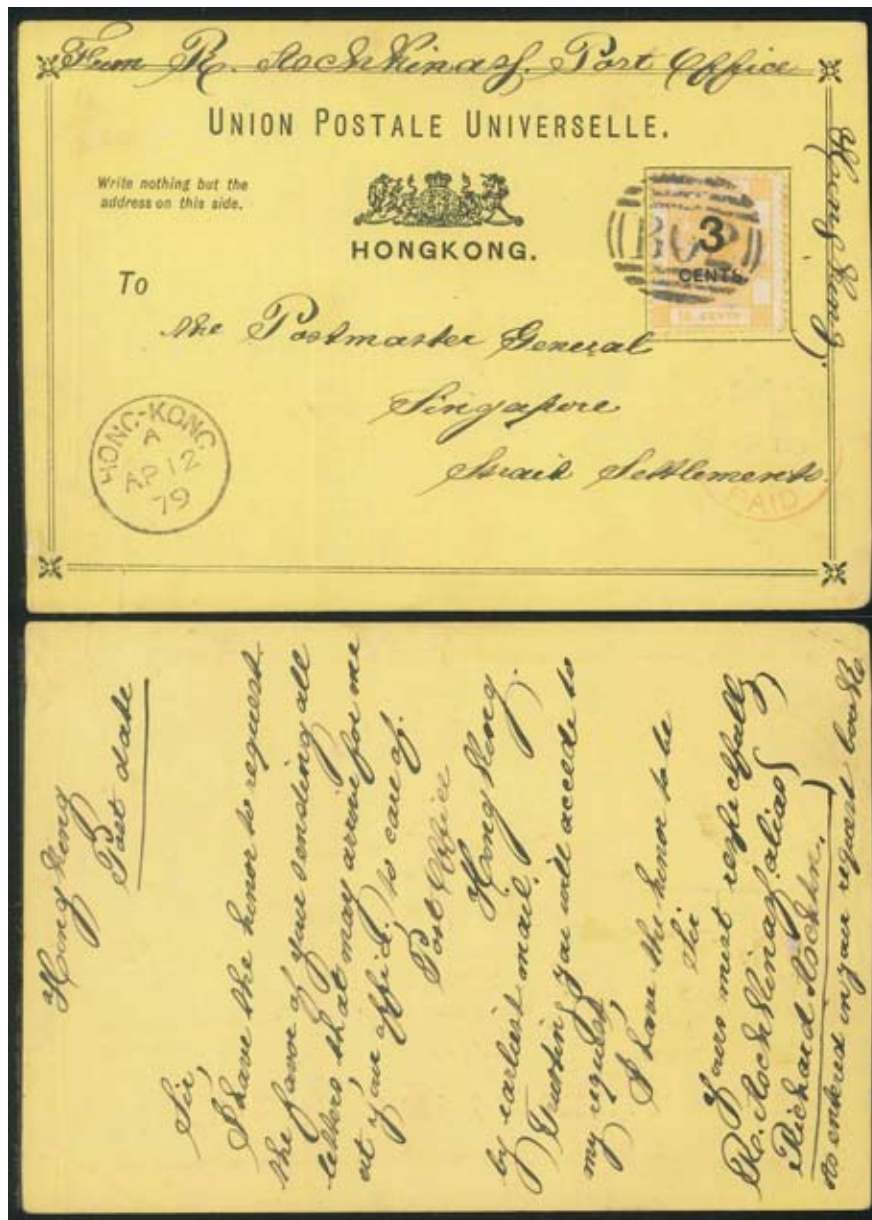
*In time, he concentrated on the, then, little understood field of postal stationery with his father, developing collections of German States, Persia, Indian States, British Africa, and of course, Asia. Beyond this, he basically wrote the postal stationery section of *The 19th Century Issues of El Salvador* by Guillermo Gallegos for the Royal Philatelic Society, because it seemed the great complexity of the subject needed to be set straight after so many generations of confusion. He also has brought together a one-of-a-kind collection of Russian Postal history as found on Russian stationery including zemstvos, and he is working on a book requested by the Rossica Society covering a small but significant section of stationery rising out of the Russo-Turkish war of 1877 which had a lasting historical effect.*

In saying this about himself, he hopes to indicate the limitless journeys and fulfillments that philately can still afford the curious and intellectually alive like yourselves.

Queen Victoria Postal Cards 維多利亞女皇郵資片

The First Postal Cards were provisional and locally Produced with adhesive stamps added rather than with printed indicia. This was because printing of the actually ordered cards was behind schedule at De La Rue in England due to demands based on the new UPU rulings. The cards were primarily for use to Europe: 3c slow mail via Marseille, France or fast mail 5c via Brindisi, Italy. However, the 3c card was also meant for use to the Far Eastern Empire. One such example has been reported used to Singapore and is shown below.



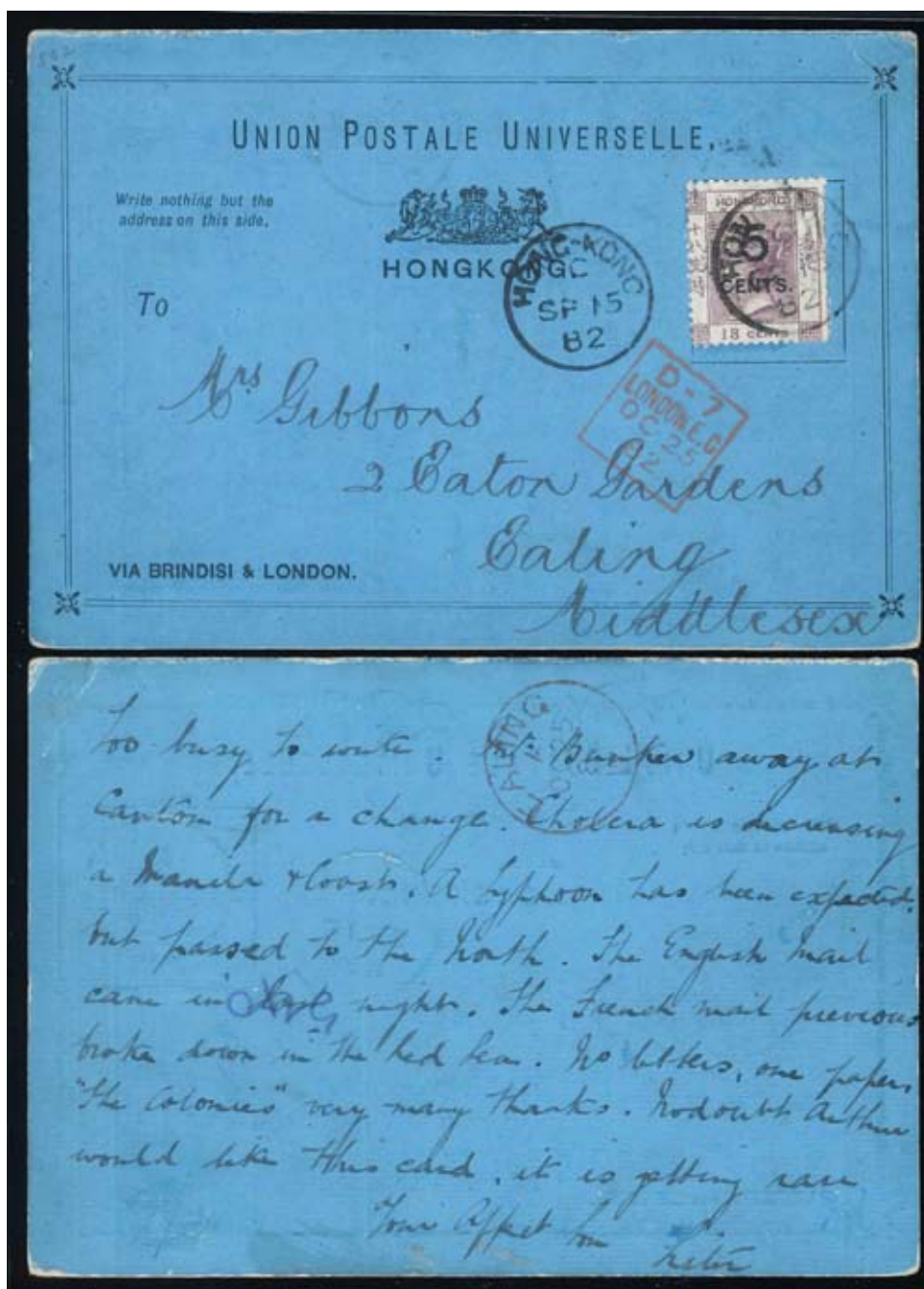

FIRST PROVISIONAL ISSUE (April, 1879)

1879.04.12 (April 12) Hong Kong QV Surcharge 3/CENTS on 16c Yellow Card with Black Printing to the Postmaster General of Singapore, Straits Settlements (#P1; H&G 1). The writer of this card explains that he has just moved to Hong Kong, and so, asks that all his further mail be forwarded. This is a very early use as well as the only reported example to a local area destination: Singapore, and NOT, as usual, to Europe. The red receiver and all markings are on the face.

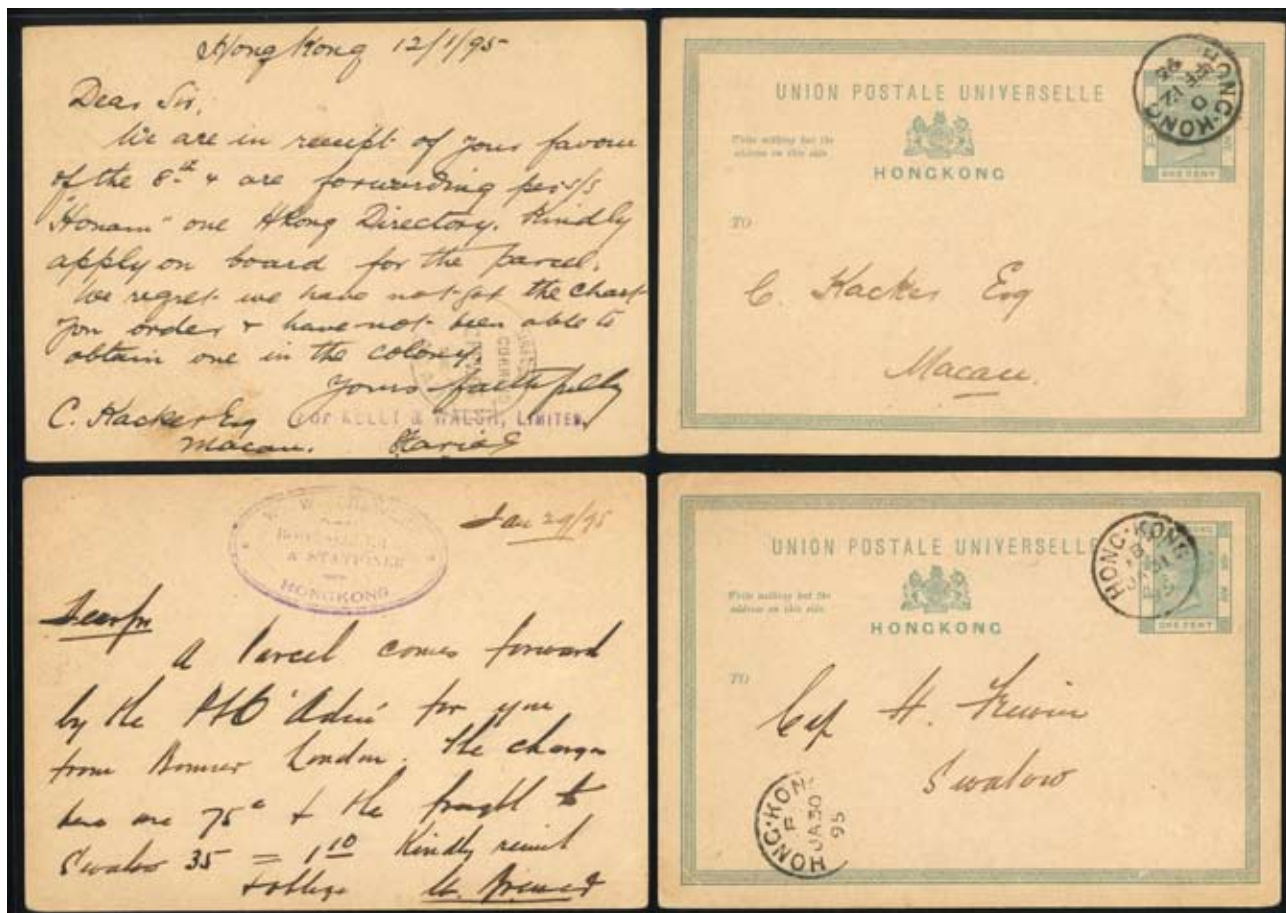

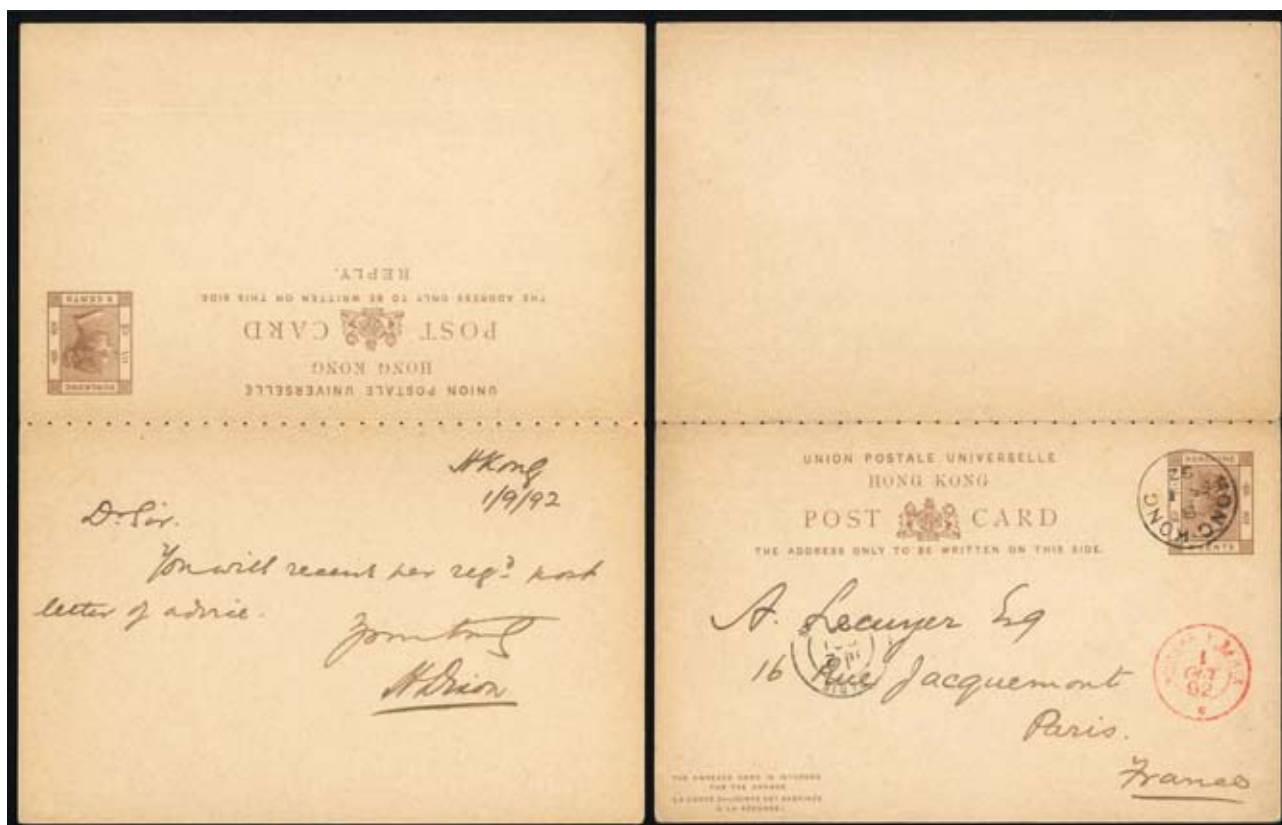

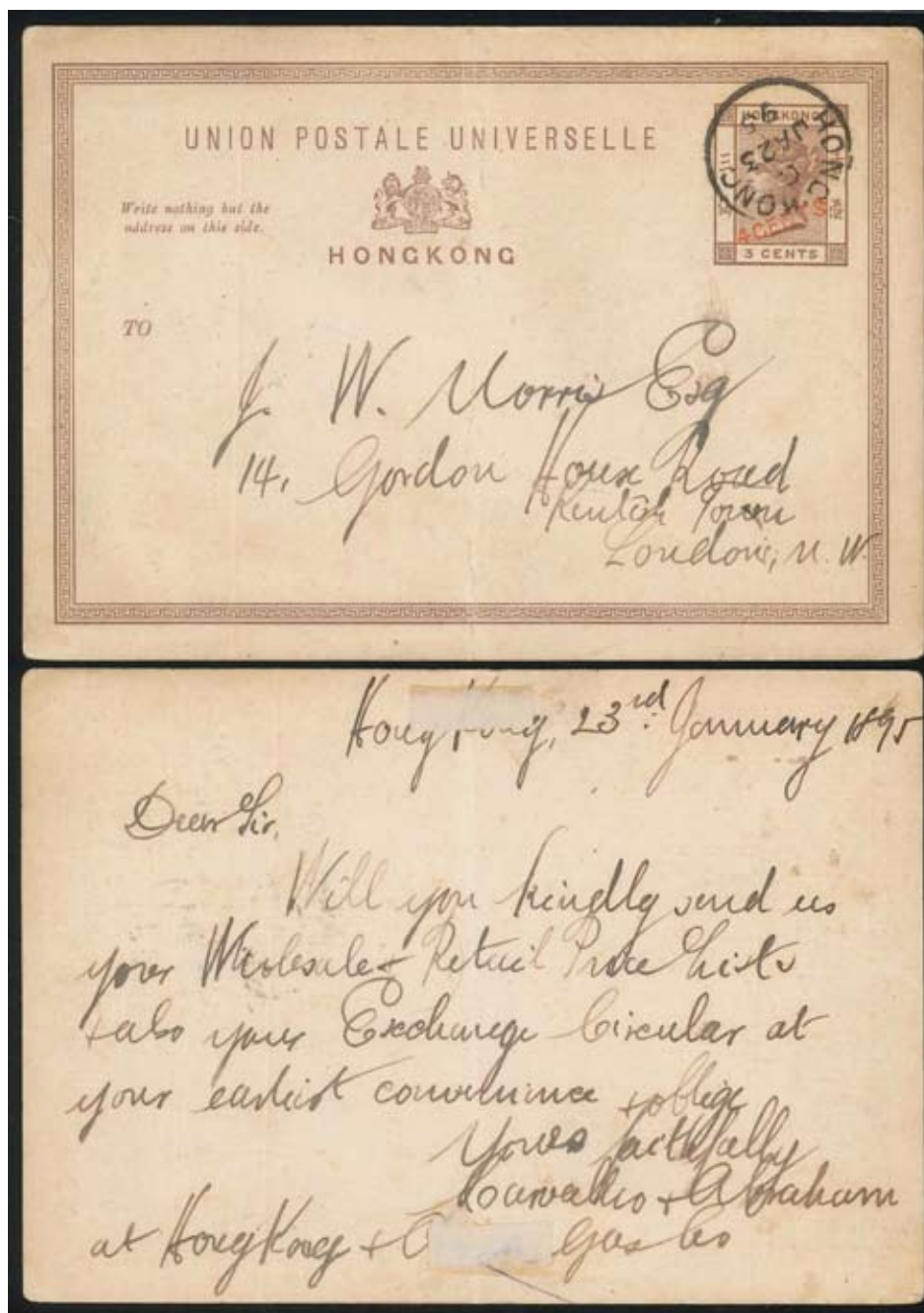

1895.01.12 (January 12) Hong Kong QV 4 CENTS Surcharged in Red on 3c Brown Reply Postal Card (#P14; H&G 13), this being an earliest known example after the new rate of 4c which began on December 1, 1894, sent to France, bearing Dijon RR Station and transit markings as well as the Montbéliard arrival cds, a clean and strikingly beautiful example with real message.
