Starting prices have been given for all lots in this auction. They are meant to reflect our idea of the lowest market value of the item given its scarcity and condition. Lots normally open at or above and may sell for more as biddings dictate.

Postal Bid Forms should be sent or faxed to be received by our office before 12 midnight prior to the day of the auction. For afternoon auctions no later than 12 noon on auction day. Extension on lots should be noted on bid forms. For lots that requested extension, Phila China will submit the item to Mr POON Kam Leung, AIEP, (Association Internationale des Experts en Philatélie), of Experts and Consultants Limited (Hong Kong) for certificates, providing that the lot will be paid for in full plus all charges for expertizing, including courier charges, insurance and handling at the time of purchase. All costs and charges for expertization are the sole responsibility and liability of the buyers.

All lots will be sold to the highest bidder. A 25% Buyer's Premium will be added to the hammer price, on all lots. The buyer agrees to pay all shipping and handling costs. It is solely the buyer's responsibility to notify Phila China Limited of any special shipping instructions.

In the case of tie bids or any other disputes arising, the auctioneer's decision will be final. The auctioneer retains the right to act as seller's agent in placing a protective reserve on any lot.

Phila China is proud to present an important series of auctions featuring the stamps and postal history of China collection painstakingly compiled by a renowned philatelist for over half a century. Nothing is too small to be offered, it will be a great collection to be enjoyed and shared.

Almost all gems of imperial China to early Republic period will be presented together with ultimately difficult to find Shanghai Postal System and early Taiwan stamps. The postal history material to a large extent, includes rare and difficult to come by items in decades, ranging from pre Customs mail to and from China, through an impressive array of Large Dragon covers with many unique examples to Chinese Imperial Post, and the Customs Mail Matter items are equally stunning.

An outstanding philatelic item always has a great story behind it, and that story often evolves around provenance. The owner gives it an allure far beyond its intrinsic value.







1.1 PRE-HANDSTRUCK POSTAL MARKING PERIOD

Prior to the establishment of postal facilities in Shanghai, correspondences traveled privately, through consulates, trading companies, and forwarding agents. As a result, there were often no postal markings until such mail reached their transit and arrival destinations. This practice continued in the pre-adhesive period during the formative phases of the postal system in Shanghai.

datelined 29 June 1846 Carried privately from Shanghai to Hong Kong then aboard P&O Lady M. Wood to Galle, continuing on to Yorkshire via Marseille, with a manuscript "1/10" rate marking, the standard British Packet rate for mail under 1/4 ounce between China and England via Marseilles.

On reverse, Hong-Kong double-lined Webb Type 9 transit cds in black (18 August), transit cds (26 October), and Manchester arrival cds in red (27 October).



21 December 1851 Entire letter from Shanghai to London via Marseilles

The "2/2" rate marking covering the standard rate (1 shilling 10 pence) plus 4d. ship letter fee.

On reverse, Hong-Kong double-lined Webb Type 9 transit cds in black (19 January 1852) and London arrival cds in red (17 March 1852).







1.4 Accountancy Markings

Beginning in 1836, the French and British signed a series of postal treaties and conventions that eased international mail delivery. In particular, the Convention of 1839 allowed mail between France and the East Indies to go through France via Marseilles instead of Gibraltar. Diamond shaped handstamped accountancy markings were introduced in 1860 and revised in 1866 to facilitate accounting between the two countries.



3 September 1861 Envelope from "Buissonnet & Co./Shanghae (Chine)" to Lyon via Marseilles bearing a **GB/1f 62 ½oc** mark and a crossed out **GB/1f 80c** accountancy marking applied in Hong Kong. The 1f 62 ½oc per 30 gram rate was used for mail from places in the Orient that were British Possessions to France or vice versa while the 1f 80c per kilo rate was to be applied to printed papers.

On reverse, Hong Kong Webb Type 13a transit cds (8 September) and Lyon arrival cds (27 October), both in black.

October 1861 Cover to Paris via Marseilles with sender's blue "VAUCHER FRERES/SHANGHAI CHINE" handstamp exemplifying the **GB/1f 62 ½oc** accountancy marking. This letter was probably carried by agent to Hong Kong where the mark was applied, continued on British packet boat to Marseilles, and traveled overland to Paris. Hong Kong Webb Type 13 transit cds (14 October) and Marseilles à Paris cds (26 November) on reverse, both in black.


15 November 1863 Letter from Yokohama to Marseilles demonstrating the usage of the **GB/1f 22 ½** accountancy marking, a rate that was used for mail from places in the Orient that were not British Possessions to France or vice versa.

The letter passed through Shanghai (8 December, Webb Type Bi cds in black on reverse) per PO CJ Oden, Hong Kong (12 December, Webb Type 13 cds in blue on reverse), aboard P&O steamer *Orissa* to Galle, P&O *Mooltan* to Suez and finally, arriving in Marseilles aboard P&O *Vectis* on the 25th of January 1864.

George Frederick Seward of Florida, New York, nephew of Secretary of State William Henry Seward, was confirmed as consul of the United States at Shanghai on December 23, 1861 and was nominated to be consul general of the United States at Shanghai in a little over two years time on January 7, 1864. He served until 1876 and during his tenure he was the person responsible for mails to and from America residents in China. His recommendations were mostly adopted when the postal treaty between Hong Kong and United States became effective in 1867. However, as the treaty stipulated that Hong Kong mails, and mails of the Hong Kong treaty ports, were to be handled by the British postal service, no American postal agents were needed in those cities. Diplomatic dispatches and correspondence from the American consuls in those cities, all of which was supposed to go to Shanghai, was presumably handled directly. With the running of PMSS steamer service out of Shanghai in 1867 it is only natural for mail to and from China being handled in Shanghai. In turn, the postal agency left the distribution of mails to and from northern China, including the British treaty ports, to the Americans. Rather than institute a new system for this mail distribution, the Americans utilized one of the existing foreign mail systems or the Chinese posts to meet this obligation. Special couriers were used to carry diplomatic mail between Shanghai and the Chinese capital at Peking.
